



APPLICATION FOR FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO STUDY AT UTAB

The University of Technology and Arts of Byumba (UTAB), in partnership with **Chancen International**, invites applications from eligible candidates for a “**Study Now–Pay Later**” financial scheme to pursue undergraduate studies at UTAB.

The financial scheme applies to the following undergraduate programs, all offered at **UTAB Byumba Campus** in the **Day Program mode**:

1. Bachelor of Science with Honours in Animal Production;
2. Bachelor of Science with Honours in Crop Production;
3. Bachelor of Science with Honours in Forestry and Natural Resources Management;
4. Bachelor of Science with Honours in Renewable Energy;
5. Bachelor of Arts with Honours in Social Work.

The **Chancen’s Income Share Agreement (ISA)** covers education costs during the study period. ISA beneficiaries should agree that after graduation, they will start repayment which is applicable when they start earning an income, in accordance with the **Study Now–Pay Later** scheme.

Applications must be submitted online through the UTAB Management Information System (UMIS) via the links below **not later than 19th July 2026**.

Each application file must include the following documents:

1. A notarized copy of the Secondary Education Certificate, with at least 50% of marks or two principal passes for applicants who completed secondary school before 2024;
2. A copy of the National Identity Card.

Important Notes

- Applicants must meet the UTAB admission requirements and comply with the Income Share Agreement eligibility criteria established by Chancen International.
- Admission to UTAB does not automatically guarantee financial support.
- Admitted candidates will be required to attend a mandatory Chancen’s ISA workshop, together with their guardians, prior to the start of classes.

- Candidates who are granted Chancen's ISA financial support will be officially notified in collaboration with Chancen and UTAB to start their studies with **September Intake 2026**.
