INVITATION TO BID (ITB)

TENDER FOR THE SUPPLY OF LAMBDA CYHALOTHRIN 50 EC PESTICIDE FOR THE CONTROL OF COFFEE ANTESTIA BUG (*Antestiopsis* spp.) IN RWANDA

The **Coffee Exporters and Processors Association in Rwanda (CEPAR)**, through the **CEPAR Fertilizer and Pesticide Fund**, invites eligible and qualified bidders to submit sealed bids for the supply of **30,000 litres of Lambda Cyhalothrin 50 EC pesticide** in accordance with the technical specifications provided in the bidding document.

Quantity: 30,000 litres

Delivery Terms: CIP Kigali (NAEB Warehouse, Gikondo)

- The supplier shall be responsible for transportation, insurance, customs clearance, and delivery to the NAEB Warehouse in Kigali.
- Offloading shall be the responsibility of the supplier.

Payment Terms: 100% payment upon successful delivery and acceptance of the goods.

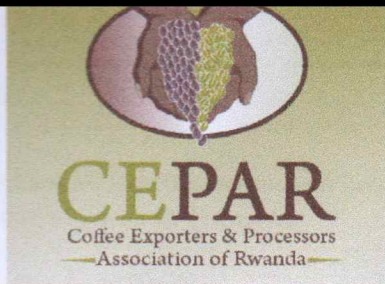

Documents Comprising the Bid

The bid shall include the following:

- a. Bid Submission Letter signed and stamped by the authorized signatory.
- b. Copy of a valid Trading License.
- c. Original or certified copy of the Social Security Certificate (for local companies).
- d. Detailed technical description demonstrating compliance with the required technical specifications.
- e. Written authorization or Power of Attorney authorizing the signatory to commit the bidder.
- f. Manufacturer's Authorization indicating:
 - Availability of the required pesticide (or expected delivery date to the NAEB Warehouse, Gikondo);

- Exact storage location of the pesticide at the time of bid submission (Country and Town of origin);
- Confirmation that delivery by **30 September 2026** can be achieved.
The authorization must be signed and stamped by the manufacturer.

g. Financial Proposal in **Rwandan Francs (RWF)**, clearly stating that the quoted price is **All Taxes Inclusive (ATI)**. The words "**All Taxes Inclusive**" must appear explicitly on the quotation, which shall be signed and stamped.

h. Original or certified copy of an Independent Laboratory Certificate of Analysis for the pesticide.

i. Any other supporting information the bidder considers relevant to the evaluation process.

Technical Specifications of Pesticide: LAMBDA-CYHALOTHRIN 50g/l EC for the control of coffee pests in Rwanda.

1. Product Profile:

Active ingredient: Lambda- Cyhalothrin 50 EC
Formulation: 50 g/l EC
Chemical family: Synthetic Pyrethroid
Chemical formula: C₂₃H₁₉ClF₃NO₃
Physical state: Light yellow liquid
Physical and Chemical properties:

2. Quantities: 30,000 litres

3. General conditions

1. The bidders are required to give a written commitment in respect of "*International conduct code for the distribution and usage of pesticides*" of FAO (annex 3) and to conform (by writing) that they accept the obligations regarding their responsibility for the product supplied.
2. The Bidders are required to provide a declaration on the composition of the product showing:
 - The content of active component; the solvents and other additives content; and the impurities content in active ingredient.
 - The name of the true manufacturer of the active ingredient.

4. Information on product quality

1. Regardless of whoever are the manufacturers, distributors or agents the bidders must show that the product offered complies with the FAO specifications (by providing a complete report from a certified laboratory) the "GLP" Good Laboratory Practices.
2. The product should remain with expiration date of more than one year and a half from the date of delivery.

5. Conditions for packaging

Bidders must undertake:

- All of the packaging (external cartons and containers) must conform to article 10 of "International conduct code of distribution and utilization of Pesticides of the FAO. "
- Sealing of containers should be sufficiently tight so as to avoid any leakage
- Cartons will play a role of secondary protection of containers at the time of handling, stacking and transport.
- Cartons should be rigid enough to resist to damages which may occur on content.
- Containers will have a liquid content of **1 Litre max**; should be plastic jerry cans or made of stainless-steel having an interior surface coated with anti-corrosion agent and should resist diffusion of the product.
- Containers should allow for easy handling with minimal risk of exposure to users.
- Containers should have strong handles.
- Tops should be fixed firmly on the containers to ensure they are water-tight.
- Measuring dispensers adapted to local conditions (dosers or graduated-cap in ml) must be provided at the rate of 1 measuring device per 1 Litre.

6. Conditions for labeling.

6. Conditions for labeling.

Bidders should undertake:

- Labeling of product in order to confirm with Article 10 of International conduct code of distribution and utilization of Pesticides of FAO.
- Bidders will provide a model of labeling of the product and directions concerning the use of proposed product.
- Labeling of the product is printed with indelible (permanent) and weather- resisting ink.
- Labeling of the product should comply with the color code of OMS and have required pictograms.
- Labels should be printed in Kinyarwanda, French, English or both.
- Labels must provide only information related to coffee; no information related to other crop requested.

7. Labeling of products will have following information:

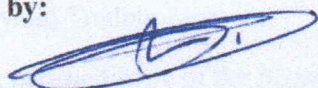
- AO and batch number.
- Product name
- Identification and concentration of active component.
- Formulation
- Description and concentration of solvents
- Net contents.
- Date of formulation, expiration and batch number.
- Lifespan of the product.
- Uses for the product.
- Directions for use (application rates, preparation,..)
- Safety date on storage.
- Directions for safe handling, storing, transporting.
- Safety advice, first aid treatments, antidotes, medical advice and legal responsibilities.
- Directions for storage.
- Recommendations for disposal of packaging material
- Name and address of the manufacturer as supplier or agent.

8. Conditions relating to supply of pesticide

When the tender is launched, successful bidder is required to sign a commitment that he will supply the required quantities of pesticide in accordance with the specifications and the requirements given in the present tender document.

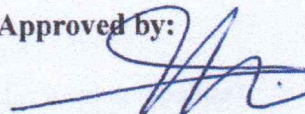
